The workshop will provide seminars highlighting mass animal mortality response including biosecurity, euthanasia, disposal options, cleaning and disinfection, and lessons learned from recent highly pathogenic avian influenza and NC flood events.

Following the workshop field demonstrations will showcase various equipment and technologies used during mass animal mortality events to manage euthanasia, disposal, cleaning and disinfection. Turkey, chicken and swine compost windrows will be demonstrated and will include carbon sourcing, construction, management, turning and troubleshooting practices. Site selection assessment for both outdoor composting and on-site burial will also be covered. In-vessel composting will also be demonstrated for routine mortalities.
